Emergency Order #34

Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers signed Emergency Order #34 that went into effect at 8am on April 29th.

This order allows nonessential businesses to provide curbside drop-off of goods and animals, allows companies to rent boats, kayaks, ATVs, and other recreational vehicles. Automatic car washes and self-service car washes will be able to operate as well as long as there is no direct customer contact, and payment is made online or over-the-phone. The order also enables golf courses, construction businesses, and landscapers to do business with certain restrictions.
