World Hepatitis Day 2019

Hepatitis A

- 4,000 new infections each year
- Outbreak still occurs in United States
- Common in many countries
- Can last a few weeks to several months

Hepatitis B

- 850,000 people have it; 21,000 new infections each year
- About 2 in 3 people don't know they're infected
- Leading cause of liver cancer
- Ranges from mild illness to life-long condition

Hepatitis C

- 2.4 Million people have it; 41,000 new infections each year
- 50% of people with Hepatitis C don't know they're infected
- Leading cause of liver transplants and liver cancer
- Range from mild illness to life-long condition
