COVID-19 Vaccine

Whether it's Pfizer, Moderna or another pharmaceutical company, the importance of getting a COVID-19 [vaccination](#) when it becomes available is critical to reduce the skyrocketing numbers of people infected with the virus. Importantly, more people that are vaccinated will increase the "herd immunity" in your community. When the time comes, be prepared to receive the COVID-19 vaccine so that your immune system will be primed and ready to combat the virus.

Close Contact With COVID-19

According to the CDC, someone who is infected with the coronavirus that causes COVID-19 can spread the virus to others as early as 2 days prior to showing symptoms and up to 10 days after the first signs or symptoms first appear. The disease is spread by being in close contact with an

infected individual. Someone in **close contact** is now defined as being within 6 feet of an infected individual for a total of 15 minutes (or more) over a 24-hour period. This can lead to virus transmission from one individual to another.

NEW GUIDELINES FOR "CLOSE CONTACT"

- 6** WITHIN 6-FEET OF INFECTED PERSON
- 15** FOR A COMBINED TOTAL OF 15 MINUTES
- 24** WITHIN A 24-HOUR PERIOD
- 48** 48 HOURS BEFORE SYMPTOMS OR TEST
