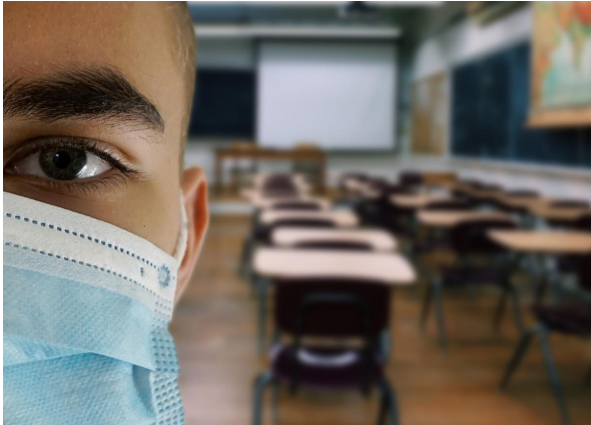
Back To Work

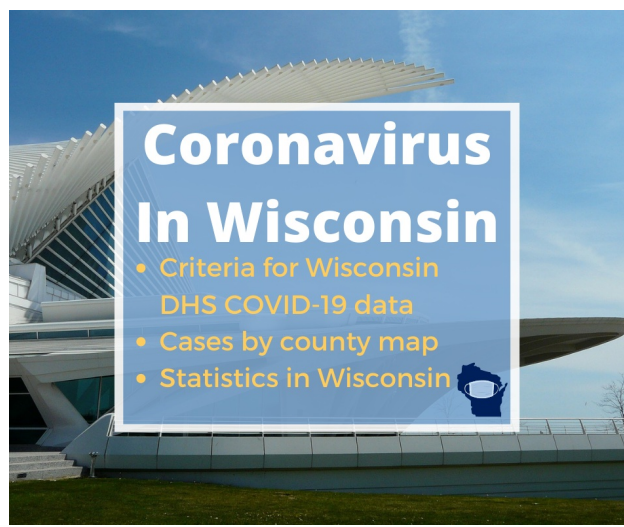
Positive COVID-19 Cases At Our Wisconsin Universities
